The Morris 8-10 cwt. Van

DEFINITELY proved to be unapproachable in its class, the Morris 8-10 cwt. Van has achieved this enviable position by reason of its absolute reliability—a feature of outstanding importance to the trader—and its exceptional general economy. The powerful four-cylinder engine of 14/32 h.p. is capable of quick acceleration and excellent hill-climbing with a full load of 8-10 cwt. while the sturdy frame and long semi-elliptic springs, effectively controlled by progressive shock absorbers, provide a degree of riding excellence which ensures that the most delicate of goods can be carried without damage.

The engine possesses a bore of 75 mm, and a stroke of 102 mm, giving a cubic capacity of 1802 c.c. It is equipped with side valves and detachable head which facilitates decarbonisation. A smooth-acting multi-plate clutch with cork inserts is built in unit construction with the engine and three-speed gearbox, and is automatically jubicated from the engine. Full five-lamp Lucas lighting and starting equipment is provided, employing a combined dynamo and starter motor (dynamotor). A powerful foot brake operating on all four wheels in reinforced pressed-steel drums is fitted, while the hand brake operates independent shoes in the rear drums.

The Morris 5-cwt. Van

REPRESENTING the most economical delivery transport procurable to-day, the Morris 5-cwt. Van makes special appeal to the tradesman whose primary consideration is maximum operation economy. The remarkably efficient four-cylinder side-valve engine of the 5-cwt. Van possesses a bore of 57 mm and a stroke of 83 mm, giving a cubic capacity of 847 c.c., and has ample power for every circumstance, with a petrol consumption approaching forty-five miles to the gallon.

Owing to its modest dimensions it is particularly suited for use in traffic-congested districts where full advantage can be taken of every small break in the traffic conditions.

The engine is carried in a sturdy downswept frame supported on semi-elliptic springs front and rear, which are well controlled by progressive shock absorbers, thus providing excellent riding qualities, while the brakes are very powerful and operate on all four wheels whether actuated by hand or feet, ensuring the maximum safety.
